



WINES TO TAKEAWAY

All our wines are sourced from small artisan growers who work sustainably, practicing organics or biodynamics in the vineyard. Much of the farming is labour-intensive, often done with horses rather than tractors and all of the picking and selection is done by hand. Yields, usually from old vines are low. Fermentations tend to be with wild yeasts; with most wines unfiltered and unfinned and without the addition of sulphur dioxide and other additives.



Inside you can find a selection of winemakers who we feel really epitomise the meaning of terroir and produce wines that reflect the condition of the land and the fruit of every different vintage. Some may focus on a single grape, others a range of varieties and parcels across a region but they all trust in the purity of their fruit and its ability to produce real wine without the help of chemicals and other commercial processes.

Bubbles

Be it Pet' Nat, Prosecco, Cava or Champagne, bubbles are not just fun, but a beautiful pairing with many dishes on the menu. A Terroirs' favourite, Pet'Nat, is actually far from being the "new kid on the block". In fact, this funky and fun sparkler dates back pre-Champagne! Long story short, the wine is bottled prior to fully completing its first fermentation, allowing carbon dioxide to be produced by the natural sugars found in the grapes.

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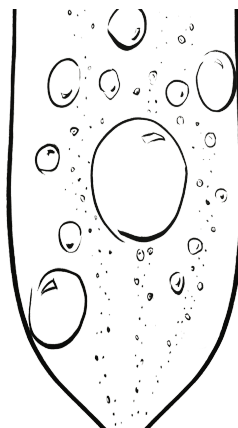

Loire

Cool climate and unpronounceable soils: Phtanites, Tuffeau, Orthogneiss, Phelspat and Schist define the region. This mosaic of Terroirs leads to complexity throughout the area, true wines of the sea and soil.

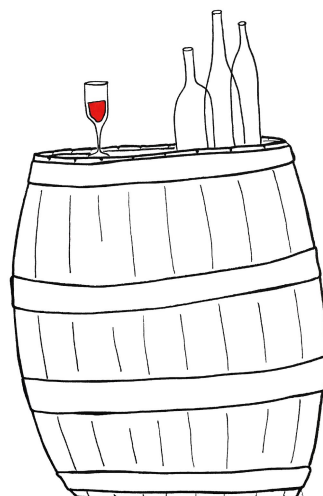

With climate ranges from the cooler areas of Central Otago and Canterbury to the warmer regions of Auckland, you can expect a different expression with each wine. Cool, crisp and adventurous.

Skin Macerated Whites

Don't listen to the fake news; no oranges have died in the making of these wines. Skin macerated or 'orange' wines are made in the style of a red wine, though technically 'white' as made from white grapes. Instead of pressing and removing the skins, as you would for whites, they are left on to ferment and to macerate. This ancient style of winemaking, originating from Georgia, imparts the phenols and colour pigments of the skins to the wine transforming its flavour and texture and a golden, amber or outright orange hue.

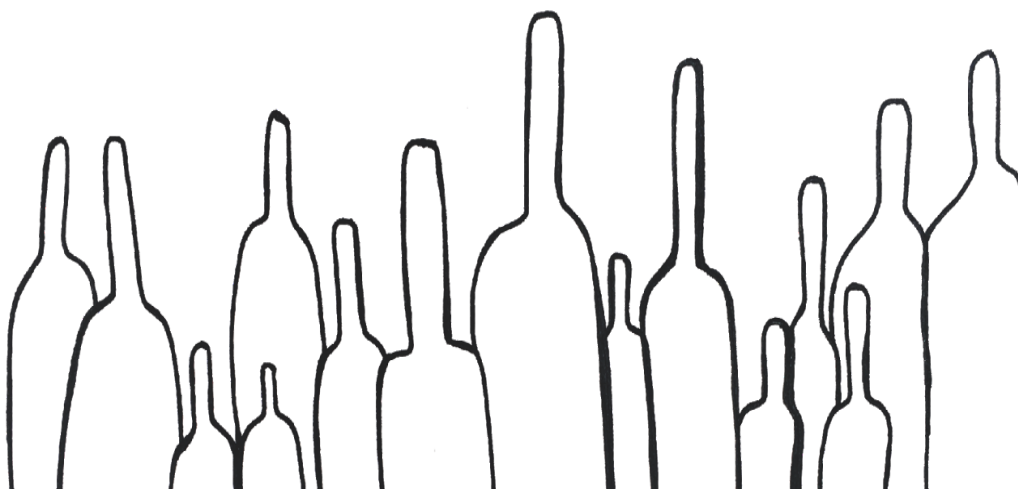

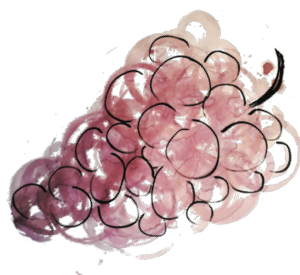
Rhône Valley
